Recruitment Milestones

- In January we saw a total of **30** participants recruited and **18** randomised.
- So far in February, **12** participants have been recruited and **20** randomised.
- **Homerton Hospital** randomised participant **690** (HOM/0934) to the study!
- **St Barts Hospital** randomised the **165th** TILT participant (SBH/0265) in November!
- **Princess Anne Hospital** randomised their **98th** and final participant (PAH/0154) to TILT!
- **Hammersmith Hospital** today randomised TILT participant number **60** (HMS/0078)!
- **CRGW, Plymouth** reached **69** TILT randomisations (DER/0093) in November!
- **Chinese University of Hong Kong** randomised participant **305** (UHK/0382) in January!
