STUDY UPDATES

1. **Homerton** recruited their 100th participant on 24th October and randomised their 100th couple on 29th November. Congratulations to everyone involved! 100
2. As of today (14th December 2018) there have been a total of 148 participants recruited and 111 randomised.
3. **Bath Fertility Centre** opened to recruitment on 12th November and have been screening potential participants over the last month. Welcome to the TILT family Bath!
4. **Hammersmith Hospital** had their SIV on 16th October and **St Bart's Hospital's** was on 22nd November. Both sites will begin recruitment in the new year.
5. **Princess Anne Hospital** in Southampton will be having their SIV in January

Anna McLaughlin from the embryology team at Homerton, a big fan of the newsletter and regular correspondent, wrote in to share her team's experience of the TILT trial with everyone.

Hello from Homerton! As you all may know we were the first site to begin recruitment and randomisation for the TILT trial, and we are now delighted to say that so far we have randomised 100+ patients.


It has been an important few months for the TILT trial. From an embryology perspective we have found the trial to be somewhat of a learning curve; implementing such a large scale trial which involves so many of our patients into the lab was challenging at the beginning, but ultimately rewarding. The team are always very intrigued to see which arm of the trial the patients are randomised to, and of course disappointed if a patient can't be randomised for whatever reason.

I am excited to see the addition of more recruiting centres, both nationally and internationally! I hope you all have a Merry Christmas and a very Happy (TILT) New Year!
